



## **APPLICATION FOR FIRST YEAR SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Interfaith Seminary has raised a fund that will offer partial scholarships to several first year applicants. We wish to offer support to probably three or four applicants in whom we perceive genuine financial need **in combination** with a sense of their perceived clear attunement to the purpose of the training.

To be considered for a first year scholarship, which is unlikely to exceed the value of £1,000, please include with your enrolment form a letter or e-mail letter addressed to The First Year Scholarship Group, and for the attention of our administrator Lindsay Jarrett, that clearly responds to the following questions. Do not exceed 2 pages or its equivalence in length, and respond to all of the questions.

- 1. Please share your circumstances of financial hardship*
- 2. Share your full earnings*
- 3. What responsibilities do you have, including dependents*
- 4. What else are you doing to raise money*
- 5. Do you have any capital*
- 6. How much scholarship award would make a difference*
- 7. Please suggest a scholarship that you would like to receive.*
