Key strategic goals for 2009 - 2011

As a spirit-led organisation it feels incongruous to establish our goals for the organisation. These proposals arise from where we feel we are being asked to lead the organisation over the next two years. Spirit will determine where we are to go in our work, and these proposals will evolve. Our primary goals for this period are to:

1. Grow the organisation through the continued deepening and relevance of the Seminary's training programme, including enrolling students, exploring new training centres either run directly or through licensed partners
2. Create a vibrant, self-sustaining community of ministers

In addition, within the available resources, we will seek to enable the work of 1 and 2 in the following ways:

3. Create an effective spiritual, leadership, governance and management structure for the Foundation
4. Raise awareness of, collaborating with, and influencing related 'spiritual' work through linking and partnerships with external bodies and organisations both locally and internationally
5. Raise the profile externally of the Interfaith Foundation's work
6. Develop the financial strategy so as to achieve sustainability, a financial surplus by 2010/2011, and consider development and investment opportunities.
