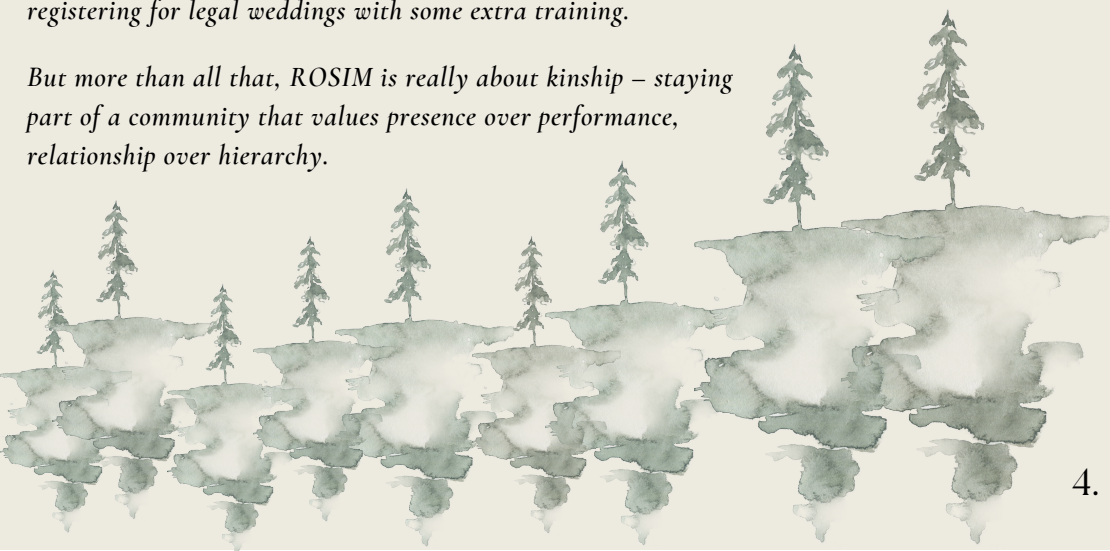
So, what happens now? Well, we'd love you to stay close.


